IMPORTANT:

Your coaching program horse must demonstrate the following qualities for this program. Stallions and green broke mounts are not suitable for this program. You want to bring your most advanced and steady horse as part of the program includes mentored teaching and students will be riding your horse as well. (This is not to mean that your horse will be used in any sort of lesson program – the mentoring portion involves supervised, graded lesson development and exposure to various riders and we all want them to be safe and confident.)

Quiet Confident Non-reactive Patient Obedient Tolerant

The horse you plan to bring to the program must be the horse that you ride in your Audition. If there needs to be a change after you have registered — a new audition video must be submitted without additional fees.

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HORSE ACCOMODATIONS:

Vaccinations: All horses must show proof of having been vaccinated for the following:

no longer than 4 wks AND no later than 2 wks before arrival

Rabies, Tetnus, Influenza, Rhino, West Nile

(this is the minimum requirement – other additional respiratory vaccinations at your discretion)

A current Neg. Coggins test

- Dated no earlier than March 1 for Spring & Summer sessions

- Dated no later than September 15 for Fall Session

Any horses that exhibit signs of a health risk will need to be quarantined off property pending a veterinary inspection and clearance at the owner's cost.

Stabling: Indoor Stall (matted) or Outdoor Pen depending on the season

Bedding supplied (initial setup + 1 bag/week)

Buckets (1 feed, 1 water)

Tack/Equipment: Saddle/bridle rack and locker provided

Trailer Parking: Parking area for trucks and trailers n/c

Hay: 2 feeds/daily included (approx. 20 lb/day)

Grain/Supplements: Bring Your Own — may be available by the week at local feed store

Other: Additional hay and bedding available for purchase – local feed outlet

Stalls - you are responsible for daily care

- stalls must be cleaned daily and left cleaned at the end of the course

- fees applied for staff cleaning

Water available on site

Forks, Wheel Barrows & Muck Tubs available on site

Outdoor bathing available – possible water restriction practices may apply depending on weather
